

WRC Meeting Minutes

Meeting Date: April 18, 2011

President: Meeting called to order by President, Ed Beane at 7:04. March minutes were approved with the following changes; under basketball AAV needs to be AAU.

Steve questioned, do we have AED's at Mayeski and Lions Club? If not he suggested that this would be a well needed purchase that WRC could make. Ed suggested getting quotes and we would discuss under new business at our May meeting.

Treasurer: 4364.44 in savings, 17,224.84 in checking. Suggested to have a meeting at her house with the executive board to review scholarships when needed

Dept. of Rec: County has a new contract for portable toilets and it is with United Site Services. If any problems arise with this new company, please inform the county. April 23 will be the March for Parks which will be held at the farm museum. Important alert: Mid Maryland Semi baseball league, if they are playing on any of our fields please report this to Abby immediately. Ed informed Loren that they were playing on fields at South Carroll on Sunday about a week ago.

Fac. Manager: There are 8 lights on football field side that need to be replaced. Mike Whitson is getting the bulbs and then they will be replaced. Tractor will be serviced within the next few weeks. Last Monday around 4PM the tractor container was unlocked and there was no one around or no one using the tractor, this was very disturbing; individuals need to be more responsible when unlocking and locking the container.

Program Reports:

Football/Cheer: Final registration estimated registration is cheer 90 and football 250. They are still accepting applications and are estimating around 400 combined for the season. They will be at the Mt Airy Spring Fest and the Winfield Carnival to promote the program. \$1516.00 was paid for last years dues.

Winter Cheer: Their Final destination at VA Beach was a success. Their Peewee team took 1st place and there Junior team took 2nd. Registration for next season will take place in August. Q: about summer flier – send info to Jenn by May 2.

Web Master: Daddy Daughter Dance is posted on the web site. He is rebuilding the web site to have the 40th Anniversary Logo and the ADA statement present.

Soccer: Use of facilities is in for the fall. Ed gave suggestion to be specific on the permit as to when you are using the space because we need a paper trail so unexpected doesn't occur. Schools want to be aware of who is supposed to be where and who is responsible. Q: patty-do we need UOF for field use? A: No WRC has blanket use of fields. Ed has a conflict with soccer's request on Sunday, August 7 from 11-3 because STARS will be holding their tryout that day from 10-6. This can be worked out though and Ed will contact Bryan to do that. The 8th and 12th are okay, there are no conflicts on those dates. Travel soccer is expanding from 8 teams to 10 teams.

Softball: Opening Day will be April 30. The antique care was cancelled and Dave is in need of a replacement, if you know of anyone who has one, please let Dave know. STARS tournaments are on May 14 and 15 and July 9 and 10. Additional spot a pots were ordered for the event with hand washing stations.

New Business: Opening Day fund raiser- Play It Again Sports will be present to except donations of any old sports equipment you may want to get rid of.

Old Business: Mayeski expansion–Hoping that trees on site can be put in easement to meet forestry requirements. Wanda has sent 3 e-mails to the BOE, Ray Prokoff, with no response. Once she receives the okay they can move forward. There will be a bingo on May 6 @ New Windsor and a Yard Sale on May 21.

Signage: Dave met with the county today to mark the spot where the sign will be going. Miss Utility will mark and then the sign will be installed.
