Mtg was called to order by President, Dave Taylor

Secretary: Approval of minutes from March mtg were tabled for May meeting

WRC Treasurer: \$24,000 in account with \$7222.00 in savings. \$300 administration and \$2.00 per player fee due from baseball. Reminder that monthly program reports are due to Dave Taylor and Carol each month

Program Treasurer: Represents basketball, lacrosse and summer clinics. Jean said has money in account and will have figures at next mtg.

Bill Schaffer: Need to submit 5 year capital projects (over \$20,000 in cost) list for WRC. All requests should be sent to Dave Taylor to prioritize. County has \$80,000 available for self help projects, contact Bill for form and deadlines.

Soccer: spring outdoor is in session; had elections in April all positions filled. Herb Feindison is new treasurer. Sock hop scheduled for 5/5 @ South Carroll. Upcoming registration is 5/6, 5/13, 5/20 @ SC Lobby 9am – noon.

Football/Cheer: Upcoming registration 4/29, 5/6, 5/13 and 5/20 9am – noon @ South Carroll Lobby. At field day they seeded existing fields and side lines and cleaned up behind container. 8/12 Football Jamboree. Apologize for condition of concession stand and back room area and noted this will not happen next year. On sad note, a FB player from B+ team, Ray Revelley (lived in Baltimore, but played in our program) was tragically shot in head and died during robbery attempt over Easter Weekend

New Business: Benches @ Mayeski: Dave reminded Bill about the condition of the picnic tables @ Mayeski. They are missing bolts and have several splintered edges.

Tot Lot @ Mayeski: Advised Bill it is in terrible shape. Child got stuck on broken slide. Park has outgrown the size of the tot lot. Bill said it in the county budget to update that lot. We advised that repairs or removal has to be done immediately to avoid children from getting hurt.

County Rental of Pavilion: Last year the county rented the Pavilion during the summer season while softball and baseball were having games/tournament. Bill said before they rent Mayeski Pavilion, they will let the program know to see if there is a conflict

Old Business: Daddy Dance date was moved (due to lack of participation) to 5/12 @ Swim Club @ \$50.00 each with \$10.00 extra daughter, expect to have new caterer this year. Need 150 couples to break even, hall rental was \$500.

Mayeski Drive: Due to current construction at fire house the entrance road to Mayeski Park is still in need of repair. Bill will check w/ maintenance.

Fields: It was noted that as result of fireman's carnival last year, the field behind South Carroll was damaged by ride equipment. The fireman were supposed to repair but didn't. It was discussed that we need to improve relationship with fire department, Dave will contact WFD and invite them to our next mtg as well as attend upcoming WFD.

Tractor: Price from New Holland on 26 HP 4x4 diesel with bucket, 72" belly mower and york rake \$20,000 New Holland will finance @ 0% for 3 years. This will not qualify for self help project.
