**Mtg was called to order by President, Dave Taylor**

**Secretary:** Minutes from the 1/23/06 mtg were accepted and approved

**WRC Treasurer:** \$22,118.00 in account and \$7219.00 in savings. All programs are up-to date on fees and expenses. Need amount of electrical bill that Prog treasurer paid so \$\$ can be transferred. If Lax ends season in black this year, the \$2.00 per player fee will be charged.

**Prog Treasurer:** Jean will have report for next month.

**Wrestling:** monthly reports are past due

**Soccer:** fields in terrible shape due to vandalism. Sock hop 5/5 @ SC. spring starts 3/12 for 8 weeks. Expect to hold soccer clinic 2<sup>nd</sup> week in June with tryouts 3<sup>rd</sup> week in June. Practice begins 8/1 and games begin 9/1. MAYSA (District Development program) has contacted us to see if we have fields available from 4/1 – mid June. Bill suggested they contact Gerstell Academy or McDaniel College.

**Lacrosse:** sock hops 3/10 @ SC, 4/21 @ SC and 5/19 @ Century. currently have 325 players with approx \$26,000 in account, have pending expenses of uniforms, refs, and MYLA fees, but expect to end in black this year. With construction beginning on upper field and damage to soccer field, concerned w/ practice area. Had parent who went to CC Dept of Rec on refund policy. After discussion, it was decided that policy was in writing on registration form and WRC would stand behind lax's decision. Bill Schaffer to respond to parent.

**FB/CL:** Elections at last mtg. CCFL looked into merging with CMFL to expand teams, but that was voted down by league. CCFL is looking to add a few teams. Upcoming registration dates 4/29, 5/6, 5/13 and 5/20 @ SC

**Softball:** Parents mtg 3/18. Inhouse pitching clinic 3/4. MD Stars held Ernie Parker Pitching Clinic and a Jamie Walbock Catching Clinic

**Baseball:** 325 players – 18 more than last year added two more teams. Field day 3/11; player evaluations 3/18, pitching clinic 3/26. Ed questioned who is responsible to call game for field conditions once game starts. Gary will check w/ County and get back to him. Would like to get soda machine @ Mayeski. The concession isn't always open and there is no water fountain, it was approved.

**Basketball:** younger teams end 3/4 and older teams end 3/11 with pizza party after last game. Girls 5/6 only had 2 teams and worked well with playing Freedom teams this year. HS team had 60 players and expect that to grow next year.

**Old Business:**

Fields: Gary and Dave examined all fields. With exception of back field @ Mayeski, most fields can be easily repaired. Gary will set up WRC field day and send out email either 3/11 or 3/18.

Upper Field: Bill said construction on upper field to begin tomorrow.

Paving Parking Lot: Bill said still on the books, we need \$5000 to get started. Bill will look into and get back to Dave on what needs to be done.

**New Business:**

Middle School Field Hockey: Jan Rubenstein brought proposal for summer instructional field hockey league @ Mayeski. It was decided this would be a great idea and would try to coordinate through Patti for fields and times. All funds will be payable to WRC and sent to Jean Shea and cost of \$5.00 per player charged by WRC. Jean w/ get w/ Jan to do flier and gets advertised in school flier.

Tractor: It was decided that a tractor w/ implements would be very helpful in maintaining fields. It was approved that Gary Davis will gather more information on purchase option of tractor and how the programs will share cost and present at upcoming mtg.

Tot Lot: Jackie asked about self help for tot lot. Bill said county is planning to replace tot lot @ Mayeski within 1 year.

Lights -- Mayeski Maintenance: Jackie submitted bid to have lights changed on concession stand to a dusk to dawn type light that automatically turns on, cost of 3 would be \$735.00. This was approved by board, Jackie will have contractor begin.

Painting – Mayeski Maintenance: Jackie submitted bid to have gable ends and doors repainted this season. Painting contractor said ceiling, block walls and columns would wait another year. Cost was \$975.00 This was not approved.
