

## **WRC Meeting – June 25, 2007, Mayeski Park**

**Meeting was called to order.**

### **Approval of Minutes.**

**Jim Horn** – SCHS will be undergoing a renovation and school addition. The back field will not be available Summer, 2008. He would like to invite WYFCP to the 9/14 and 9/28 home games for the kids. 9/21 – use of Mayeski Park by SCHS for cross country invitational. Need to locate key that Pineapple has for gate. Media center is undergoing renovation.

**Cannons Football – Mike** - Cannons appreciated all the support of WRC for their games. Donated \$260.00 to WYFCP, \$250 to SCHS Boosters for a football scholarship. Mike brought their dues for WRC. They will perform field maintenance as promised.

**Concerns about park** – Abby sent letter to BOE with concerns about cross country paths – trees, etc. Gary Davis brought up the road erosion and Abby suggested that we write a letter coming from WRC to have it repaired.

Gary provided a proposal on finishing the parking lot paving for \$3,360.00. Jeff Jenkins made motion to go ahead and pave the remaining parking lot and Buddy Brown 2<sup>nd</sup>. All approved.

The new tot lot is slated for this July, 2007.

**Cancellations** – Abby had a meeting with Randy Pentz from Century and Dave met with Jim Horn from SCHS regarding the cancellations and how to better handle them. Abby will be meeting with Linton Springs to discuss the cancellations and scheduling. Gary spoke about Linton Springs soccer/BB field. Now Pam Short – Freedom, wants to use self help money to improve the field. This may take the field away from WRC for use.

**Treasurer's Report** – Karen Wootton - \$22,576.59 balance in account. Karen asked about end of year forms to fill out. Abby is to put Karen in touch with right person.

Balances due per program:

LAX \$300 + \$2 per child fee

Baseball \$300 + \$2 per child fee. Baseball has paid \$5000 toward balance

Karen wanted clarification on camp and it was decided that all camps will give \$5.00 per child enrolled.

The pavilion was painted. Softball paid the painters and WRC to reimburse.

**Scholarships** – Eddie reported that the \$500 scholarships were given to Abigail Waters from SC and Megan Crampton from Century.

**Insurance** – Ed requested new certificates of insurance since the insurance is up 6/30.

**Tractor** – Due to financing issues, Gary said that the tractor company will be loaning the money for the tractor to baseball (since that is a single program). The loan is 0% financing for 60 months. Baseball will pay the \$5,000 down payment and WRC will reimburse baseball. The loan is in baseball's name with Karen's address. The payments will be \$275.04/month. The total for the tractor and attachments is \$18,000.00.

**Field** – Buddy Brown had a question for Abby regarding bleachers. She said that it was up to the individual programs to obtain them, but that the county had a contact to get them from. The idea was presented to get another container to store the tractor and attachments.

**Baseball** – no report

**Basketball** – Jean Shea – summer camps started – 42 players. Basketball paid \$1200 for SCHS gate – softball needs to reimburse basketball \$600.

**Football/Cheer** – Terry Delph – cheer registration is over – still have a few openings. Jeff Jenkins – football registration is over, some teams have a few spots. Equipment hand out is July 7<sup>th</sup>. There was some discussion about the permits for the concession stand. The temporary permit works the best per Gary.

**LAX** – They are behind in their reports. Their balance is \$7,700.00. Eddie to talk to Pineapple regarding the reports. Reports need to be up to date. The board discussed the bond issue for missing reports.

**Soccer** – Patty Schneider – still getting registrations. Approximately 257 kids, PreK to 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Down a little for 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup>. Good for PreK, 1, 2, 3 & 4<sup>th</sup> grades. Working out coaching staff, has coordinators in place. Meeting for coordinators and soccer board Saturday morning. Dan – completed tryouts, working out travel teams.

**Softball** – Stars in middle of season, tournament July 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>. There will be 58 teams at Winfield & Carroll Cty Sports Complex. There will be 24 teams at Mayeski Park July 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>. The 13<sup>th</sup> is a clinic for players. The hosting organization of a tournament to be held at the Carroll Cty Sports Complex was cancelled. Can WRC get dates – need to look into the policy for cancellations.

In house softball – 5 to 8 coaches had a few problems. Steve is starting disciplinary program. Try to get sanctioned umpires for next year.

With regards to coach problems – Abby said that she refers all calls back to the program elected officials to handle this. Looking into state wide report for listing coach problem offenders.
