Football/Cheer: Gearing up for the season. They are going to have an equipment cleanup. 400 registrants. Equipment handout will be Saturday, July 9<sup>th</sup>. Evaluations will be the weeks of the 11<sup>th</sup> and the 18<sup>th</sup> from 6-8 PM. Practice will begin the week of the 25<sup>th</sup>.

Lacrosse: Season is over and it was a successful one. Evaluations usually take place September/October so they need to coordinate field space for this.

Soccer: In-house is suffering because of travel. They are 2 months into registration and their numbers are really down. They have 128 registrants compared to 200 last year. They lost and entire team of boys who went to travel. Field use – not sure if it has been requested they are getting the last details of the schedule together and will submit request.

Softball: Travel is doing well. In-house finished on the 18<sup>th</sup>. This was a great season! July 15, 16, 30, and 31 will be the all star tournaments.

Wrestling: Out of season. August 28 they will have their planning meeting at Cascade Lake.
