Program Treasurer Report:

Jean Shea/Programs: \$12,570.45 in acct (\$11,734.42 in basketball and \$835.42 in sq dance)

Terry Smith running field hockey camp, she will deposit checks and provide financial details at next mtg.

Carol Waters/WRC: \$25,688.66 in WRC; \$1273.99 Lax; \$8.39 in AAU. Lax balance is pending check amounts paid out for golf tournament as well as \$7000+ in apparel invoices. Next year lax will need to budget for the \$300 administration fee as well as the \$2.00 per player.

Softball paid the \$300 fee, plus \$2.00 per player
