Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis. Minutes from the 2/25/02 meeting were accepted and approved by the board.

Treasurer Report: \$18,675 in account. Still need soccer BG&E cost. Baseball owes \$2.00 per player and registration fee. Softball owes \$2.00 per player fee

**Soccer:**

1. Spring season under way. Fields continue to be major problem. According to use of facilities, Winfield to share lower soccer field w/ Freedom. Bill assured Bob that Freedom would not be using that field. Bob requested Freedom be removed from the use of facilities to avoid any future problems. Bill said it was not necessary; Freedom would not use the fields. Soccer will fertilize, air-rate and seed Linton field, Bill will notify Linton.. It was noted that Freedom is using fields @ SC (hockey field and field behind tennis courts, field inside track) without a permit from Patty.

**Baseball:**

1. Registration completed, and practice has started. Total players close to last season. Will email webmaster BB schedules for website.

1. Registration complete, total players close to last season, but lost many elementary and middle schoolers, but picked up older girls.

**Sq. Dance:** 1. Registration for summer program. Would like to get younger dancers.

**Basketball:** 1. Jean mentioned would like to offer coordinators, free registration for their children. Board did not see a problem.

**Patty Taylor:** 1. Advised Easter Egg Hunt was cancelled due to Winfield and Linton give a problem about distributing flyers for Rec Council. Schools advised limit of 4 flyers per school year. It was addressed this is a problem, because Winfield Rec has 4 flyers' however, other programs, such as county program (Kids in Kitchen, Tennis Program) Woodbine Rec etc send fliers out). Bill noted according to Brd of Education guidelines, limit is 4 and it was up to school to decide on any flyers over 4. Bill was asked how to get this guideline updated, he will check and let us know. It was a shame a community event such as a Easter Egg Hunt was cancelled.

**Dave Taylor:** 1. Working on possibility of electronic filing of permits.

**Bill Schaefer:** 1. Still working on Mayeski Parks signs for park entrance.

**New Business:1.** Festus Jones addressed council on conducting a Basketball Camp for kids. He currently referees 3,4,5 grade @ Winfield and kids and parents LOVE him. Has interest of atleast 50 parents to have camp. Camp to include basic training, referee etiquette, set screens, offense and defense skills and conditioning. Has 4 person staff and conducted 16 camps in the past. Requesting Century gym (use of both gyms) 6/17 –6/22 9am – 1pm @ \$100.00 per camper. May have problem with Saturday, Bill S will request permit to include Saturday and see what happens. If approved, will include in the summer flyer.

2. Cindy Chaconas from Winfield Cheerleading program addressed council on conducting a cheerleading camp @ SC or Century. Camp sponsored by UCA, who have 20+ years experience. 1 instructor per 16 kids, 3 day camp 9-4:30pm. Bill to check on inside space at Century and Patty to check on space at SC.

3. **CAMPS:** With interest and request to hold new camps, Bill Schaefer addressed there are two types of camps. One is through rec program and other is state run camp (COMOR) with inspections, finger prints etc. Need to talk w/ Linda Silfee at county who has booklet explaining the camp process.
