Mtg was called to order by President, Dave Taylor

Secretary: Minutes from February mtg were accepted and approved

WRC Treasurer: \$26,099.366 in account with \$7222.00 in savings. \$500 bonds received from football/cheer; soccer; softball; baseball. \$300 administration and \$2.00 per player fee due from softball and baseball. Reminder that monthly program reports are due to Dave Taylor and Carol each month

Program Treasurer: Have \$\$ in account, Jean will have figures for next mtg by program

In Patty's absence, Dave asked if any scheduling concerns: (1) Square dance needs place for summer square dance (2) Soccer would like to schedule room @ SC in middle of April, possibly Mon/Wed

Bill Schaffer: Krimgold expecting to do core sample by end of month. \$56,000 in self projects submitted in February was all funded.

Soccer: indoor season ending and spring outdoor has begun. Century HS Lax continues to use and damage fields @ Linton. New board elections in April

Football/Cheer: field day 4/1; expect to clean up behind container; remove field blanket. Expect to send old fb/cheer equipment to youth group in LA. Upcoming registration 4/29, 5/6, 5/13 and 5/20 9am – noon @ South Carroll Lobby

Lacrosse: season begins 4/1; have teams participating in pre-season tournaments.

Softball: had field day last week; practice begins Saturday 4/1; 4/7 Bingo @ Gamber Fire Hall; Parade on 4/29; 5/20 Mad Madness Travel Tournament; inhouse coaches clinic. Sent extra equipment to local Woodlawn team

Square Dance: still loosing dancers, but holding together.

Basketball: season complete; had pizza parties w/ trophies. Greg Milhalko @ SCHS is having a BB camp this year

Baseball: had field day and got a lot accomplished. Pitching clinic w/ Darryl Smith. Currently 338 players this year (31 more than last) Would like to request authorization to have soda machine @ Mayeski (approved)

New Business: Potties: need potties @ Mayeski (Bill will check) Reminder to contact schools before scheduling a potty there

End of Season Banquets: Reminder from WRC that there should be no alcohol present at end of season banquets.

Old Business: Daddy Dance 4/28 @ Swim Club @ 6:30 –9:30 \$50.00 each with \$10.00 extra daughter, expect to have new caterer this year

Mayeski Drive: Due to current construction at fire house the entrance road to Mayeski Park has been damaged.

Fields: Used 10,000 lbs vibratory roller on fields @ Mayeski. Reminder that all cars should be parked in lot and not on fields. WRC owes softball \$250.00 for reimbursement of roller. Possibly look into self help to have professional treat fields, such as tru green or chemlawn

Tractor: still waiting on final pricing from New Holland

Fence: Gary said Mike Whitson @ county will support fence on front perimeter of park with post and cable, possibly just post around parking lot. Contractor must guarantee posts and contact Miss Utility prior to start.

Electric to Containers: Jackie recd bid to install circuit panel in black containers to allow light switches and electrical outlets run off of generator purchased by FB/CL. Cost would be shared between WRC, Lax and FB/CL (as they use containers) Total Cost \$3985.00. With many projects already pending, this was put on hold.
