

WRC meeting – May 21, 2007

Meeting was called to order. Introduction of Abby Gruber - Recs & Parks

Approval of Minutes - Defer to next meeting.

Parrs Ridge damage - council will not allow person to participate in rec programs. Damage is \$479.72. Restitution made. Dave Taylor spoke to principal and a police report was filed. Abby - send info to juvenile services

CARC Meeting - May 23rd - Eddie cannot make it so he asked for anyone else. Dave Taylor will be attending.

LSE Cancellations - lack of communication - Michelle at school has been cooperating lately for accommodations.

Treasurer's Report - Balance after self help is \$22,325.43 in checking and \$7,264.24 in savings for a total of \$29,589.67. This does not have the tractor expense taken out of it. Programs that owe for 2006-2007 are baseball, softball and lacrosse.

Camps – checks need to be sent to the person running the camp – then turn over to Karen. Checks need to be made out the WRC. Dave – They can be made out to an organization, not to an individual. Programs were upset about not getting to have checks made out to their own organization. Checks will run through Karen.

Scholarships – Dave Taylor – SCHS & Century – Board needs to vote on them. Applications sent to board. Some wanted to see 1 girl and 1 boy from each school to earn a scholarship. All were ok with that idea.

Parking Lot – paving of lot in the next couple of weeks.

Field – Buddy Brown – tractor is in, sign papers and deliver – sometime Friday. Gary & Buddy discussed to certify 1 to 2 people of each program to run tractor. Ok'd by board. Upper field – top soil and seed after lacrosse season.

Door handles are gone from all doors at concession. No one knows why. Replace all broken light covers at pavilion – Abby will get this done through the county.

Field Hockey summer league is requesting field space. Eddie feels that they should pay the \$300 fee and join WRC. They are advertising their league and summer camps so they should belong to WRC. There was discussion about this program being part of the summer camps for a long time now. Some felt that they should belong to WRC and be held to what other programs are expected to do. Dave to find out about how this program came about.

Abby spoke about master scheduling from the county.

PROGRAM REPORTS:

Baseball - \$21,355 balance in account. They are on budget to repay by July 30th. Will ask to have it repaid by June 30th. They provided concessions for Cannons. Tournament is June 22 – 27th for ages 7 – 12 Cal Ripken/Babe Ruth. 10 – 12 will be at Lions, 7 to 9 at Mayeski. There are 3 travel teams. Golf Outing is June 1st. They raised a lot of their money by holding Lottery raffle through the month of May. There is a basket & handbag fundraiser on June 8th.

It was brought up that we should allow handicap access through the lower field on a case by case basis. All were in favor.

Football/Cheer – Helmets reconditioned, electric to container done by this week. Cheer 145 – football 285

Lacrosse – Season winding down. 5 teams for playoffs – this week and next week. LAX MAX tournament 6/8 – 6/10th.

Soccer – 200 registrations for rec. Patti is still taking registrations. Travel soccer – spring season winding down. Tryouts 1st 2 weeks of June. Trying to fix lower field at Linton Springs. Putting top soil and hydro seed. Registration is done – coaches meeting Wed. night.

Someone brought up trees on cross country – county will be taking care of this.

Softball – Tryouts in August. Will be done by 6:00 pm – August 12th & 19th (Sundays) Will use all fields. Softball helped fix fields at Carroll County Sports Complex – tournament was held up there – 46 teams – best ever! They, too, are having scheduling issues.

Square Dance – They have facilities for the summer. Convention is in July.
