Mtg called to order, by either Gary Davis or Dave Taylor.

Minutes to the October mtg were tabled until next mtg (not yet issued)

WRC Treasurer: Lax and AAU BB have been handled over to Jean. Jean will hold all programs and Carol will hold administration only.

FB/CL still owes \$300 admin and \$2.00 per player

Wrestling still owes \$100 admin and \$2.00 per player

BB still owes \$100 admin and \$2.00 per player

BG&E bills to be sent to FB/CL and soccer as soon as they are tallied

Program Treasurer: \$55458.00 in account

Wrestling: season started

Softball: new board set, dates set for registration (same weekend as baseball). Stars to hold annual May madness on 5/21

Square Dance: no report

Lacrosse: one more registration scheduled. Registration currently 15% down overall this year, mostly younger players. Field requests and times have been submitted.

Soccer: Had a good year. Appreciation expressed for Kathleen and how hard she worked. Awards next Monday for travel.

Baseball: Calendar finalized for spring, dates set for registration (same as softball), discount offered for early registration. Will do parade again in conjunction w/ softball. Will combine w/ MAYAA and Four County for some games w/ the older kids. Concerns @ losing Lions Club, interested in finding space @ Mayeski and other places.

Football/Cheer: 3 Teams in Superbowls, 1 runnerup and 2 Superbowl Champs. Cheer Competition was huge success. End of year banquet set for 12/10 @ Century High. Field to receive 60 yds of top soil, rolled, seeded and then apply thermal blanket. Asked to remove debris by bon fire area. May have new look (uniforms) next year. Jan/Feb new board elections, current board holds 30. Thanks to soccer to share lights and field during season.

Old Business:

Park Fencing: Total cost \$13,000 for a post and cable fence around entire park. County concerned with liability. If we come up with money, next step is to go to Jeff Degitz, who has previously verbally ok'ed it. Council seems to agree to have programs chip in to pay for it. All represented programs (lax, SB, FB/CL, Baseball, soccer) agreed and rec

council will also pitch in. Vote was taken that WRC will absorb \$5000 of costs. Baseball is slightly concerned because they may not have a program due to potential loss of Lions Club fields due to development. Gary will contact county to begin the process.

Upper Field: Contractor that was issued the work PO has not yet begun work. We will pursue getting another contractor.

WRC Logo: open up the logo contest to general public to submit for artwork.

New Business:

Basic Horse Care and Safety by Holniker Farm 1.5 hrs each session with a 4 week session. \$110 – level #1; \$150 – level #2, ages 6 – adult. It was agreed WRC would sponsor and advertise in our January school flier, website and email newsletter

Problems @ Park: numerous times, damaged to fields by vehicles, police called, charged filed (trespassing, destruction of property)

SC Cross Country Date: Jim Horn has set date for cross country meet, Patti will inform

Sledding @ Mayeski: Once again this year, we will open Mayeski to sledding. Will advertise in school flier...
