**Dept. of Rec:** The valuable key to the Linton Springs Community room was given to Ed. Loren was given the file cabinet with all the WRC files and it is being kept in his office at the SC Community Center.

**Facility Manager:** A new lock will be installed on the back gate at Mayeski. It will be a combination lock and each program will be given the combination.

### **Program Reports:**

**Baseball:** Season is over. They are in the process of discussing next year's registration plans. Note: 90 ft walk through – Pete Bergman is available for that next week. Ed will set up a meeting to discuss field usage.

**Basketball:** Boys travel 4-5 and 6-7&8 Girls travel 5-6 and 7-8. Rec grades 1-8 with 400 kids registered. Games will start December 4.

**Football:** 5 teams advanced to playoffs, 2 teams advanced to the Super Bowl. 9-11 Federal, coached by John Batiste went on to win the Super Bowl and 10-12 Federal, coached by Kevin Cooper advanced to the Super Bowl but did not take the victory. WYFCP Cheer Competition – 5 teams went. There was 1 honorable mention, 3 teams took 3<sup>rd</sup> place and 1 team took 1<sup>st</sup> place. WYFCP won the Spirit Stick for the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in a row. Camfest was a huge success, it made over 25,000.00 for the Lauver family.

**Winter Cheer:** 47 girls signed up forming two teams, one 10 and under and one 10 and over

**Lacrosse:** Registration is open through November for players who attended evaluations then open registration starts December 1 for those who did not attend evaluations.

**Softball:** STARS – up and running, Gary is in charge. In House is finalizing their budget and getting ready to start. The date of opening day will move this year due to Easter. Dave would like to thank everyone for his nomination of Volunteer of the Year, he is very honored.

**Wrestling:** 118 wrestlers and registration is open through January. Numbers are down a little. 20 are on Lee High Travel and 23 are on Navy Travel and the rest are REC. Matches start on December 4 and go through March.

**Old Business:** Mayeski Expansion – see attachment. Signage: No Parking signs were 55.10 each and 6 were purchased. Emergency sign 18”x24” will cost \$330.60 and the county will install. Motion was made to go ahead, then 2<sup>nd</sup>, and everyone was okay - sign is a go. Propose to put a sign at entrance of Mayeski near Old Liberty. Who does Dave need to discuss with – Ray Prokoff at the BOE, he is the Director of Facilities. Also the entrance way repair, Ed sent e-mail to Jim Horn and got no response. The BOE contractor needs to do these repairs. There is nothing to report on Krimgold.
