Minutes from the September 2005 meeting were approved

Treasurer Report:

WRC Current Balances - \$23,784 recreation; \$3842 lax; \$8.39 AAU.

Recd bonds from FB/CL; Soccer, Softball and Baseball

Still Due: \$300 admin fee and \$2.00 per player from FB/CL; Bond, \$100 admin fee and \$2.00 per player from Wrestling; Bond, \$100 admin fee and \$2.00 per player from Basketball; Bond for Lax

Program Current Balances: \$28,492 Basketball; Daddy Dance \$835; Hockey Camp \$225 Speed Camp; \$185; Karate \$301

Jim Horn (SCHS Athletic Director) said our council has been great to work with and he understands there have been some minor problems in the past, we hope to correct that. Made list of WRC staff contact #'s for Jim to give to custodial staff in the event of problem. Discussed applying indoor permit for WRC instead of a particular sport.

Bill Schaffer: Volunteer of the Year is 11/3 @ 7:30pm - 15 Councils are Represented. 8 Self Help Projects approved, nothing for WRC, \$48,000 left for February. Bill will remind council to resubmit paying of Mayeski Park, previously approved.

Basketball: Currently have 351 boys/girls. Thanked all for help @ registration. Dicks Sporting Goods is sponsoring us and will provide kit for each coach.

FB/CL: had 2 attempted thefts. (1) tried to steal rented generator light towers, removed tongues from hitch (2) stole gatoraid and sodas from storage room @ concession, will put ceiling in that room. Final regular season this week and then playoff games. Bonfire on 10/29, Cheer Competition on 11/6 @ Ag Center, Superbowls 11/19 and 11/20 and end of year banquet on 12/10 @ Century. Gary reminded when season over and concession is clean to call him/county and they will clear water lines. Field is a major concern this season, expect to add top soil at end of season, seed and replace winter blanket.

Wrestling: Parent mtg on Friday, approx 100 wrestlers this year, practice begins in November. It was noted that during SCHS events, sometimes some of the rec program wrestlers come in the back door without paying.

Baseball: 9 acres of Lions Club staked out for development, may loose parking.

Soccer: Rec program coming to close on 11/4 and 11/5, travel will end on 11/9 and 11/20. Kathleen thanked Gary for replacing bulbs. 1 Breaker is still creating a problem and Gary will check.

Lax: Would like to apply for spring outdoor permits.

Softball: 2006 Registration fee will remain same. Coaches are responsible to get \$200 team sponsor for inhouse teams

Baseball: Replaced freezer for health dept @ Lions Club. All board positions except President has been filled. Rick Park is now VP. One fall 14/15 travel team. Expect slight increase in registration in 2006. Will coincide registration dates w/ softball. Opening day is 1st Sat in May. Would like to use lighted field @ Mayeski for some games for 9/10, 13/14.

Old Business:

Fence entire park: Park has suffered 3 turf events in the last few weeks. Cost \$12,000 total to fence entire park, grant allows \$10,000. Decided WRC will submit for self help \$\$ for spring, submit 2/3/05 and decided upon in March.

Upper Field: Still no work has begun. Bill will get w/ Rick Warner to determine approximate start date.

New Business: Softball is looking to raise funds to construct 100 x 60 storage facility @ Mayeski, all programs in attendance expressed interest in helping out
