Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis. Minutes from the 10/1/01 meeting were accepted with comment from Bob Harris (Soccer). He wanted to add note, he had to talk to person in charge of rec soccer program to determine if soccer and football could develop a “park” schedule between program for the future.

Treasurer: 1. \$ 11,800 in account.
 2. Football owes \$2.00 per player
 3. Wrestling owes \$2.00 per player and WRC fee
 4. FB and Soccer just sent BG&E bills – Gary noted our program cannot continue to absorb electric charge for SCHS to use well during August to water HS field. – possibly add water meter. Gary will talk to school.

FB/Cheer: 1. Two sea containers have been delivered and set on field. Expect to have repaired (damaged when set) and painted within two weeks. Intend to put shingled roof on top of “Press Box”.
 2. Banquet is December 3 at Martin’s West. Program pays only for children in program.
 3. Cheerleading Competition is 11/11 and Cindy is still trying to get indoor practice time. All other program, Sykesville, Westminster etc are indoors for the next two weeks. Patti is working on.
 4. 3 of 4 Teams are in the playoffs for the Superbowl. It’s been a good season with few problems.
 5. Possibly do a football clinic next year (players and coaches), need indoor classroom facility with access to gym and outdoor field.

Baseball: 1. Introduced Dave Morin new VP of Baseball (WELCOME)
 2. Expect to have December Newsletter go out to last year players about registration – last three Saturdays in January and 1st Saturday in February @ SC 10 – 2pm (Patty will schedule lobby)

- Soccer:
1. Rec program winding down. Travel teams have a few more games. Travel teams placed 2nd at Hampstead and 3rd at Hagerstown tournaments.
 2. Bob placed hay bales around light pole as req by Dept of Recs.
 3. Will do newsletter to all players and will give copy to Dave Taylor to place on website.
 4. Will have Stancovich clinic for kindergarten and 1st graders.

- Basketball:
1. Program has grown from last year – up 25%, currently have 380 players without travel teams. Having trouble getting school gym time.

- Softball:
1. Expect to have pitching clinic with AA County Instructor.

2. Problems with facilities. All winter programs are growing (wrestling, basketball etc) and gym time at SCHS is less than last year. SC Gym only available 4 days in November for WRC program. Time currently blocked by SC band, basketball and volleyball. Unable to request Century prior to 12/1 due to limited janitorial staff. We have to split Century HS w/ Freedom. Gary to meeting w/ Freedom and the county to try to resolve.
3. Have heard many Freedom parents upset w/ Freedom program.
4. WRC predominantly Carroll County (89%) students and Freedom split between Carroll County (40%), Howard County and Baltimore County.
5. Bike Rally 11/4, 11/18 and 12/2 noon to 6 pm at Mayeski
