

WRC Meeting Minutes

September 26, 2011

Facility Manager: tractor has been repaired and is at Gary's. Reminder to everyone: if you use it put gas in it and if you break it let him know before it gets worse. The lights on the third base tower on field 2 are not working. Also the lights in the pavilion left side from the parking lot are not working. A motion from Jenn for WRC to pay for the tractor repairs, motion was 2nd by Dave and all were in favor. Karen will mail a check to softball.

Webmaster: The website has been transferred to Steve. Portal will redirect to sites. E-mail addresses are needed for the flyer to be sent to all programs. Still working on AED, concern is still, where are we going to put them?

Programs:

Wrestling: Registration starts tomorrow. They had their 1st planning meeting and a coaches meeting is coming up.

- Baseball: Certificate of Insurance is still needed, one for the Fire Hall and one for Lions Club. Ed asked Loren to look into this. November 4 will be the Fall Dinner/Dance at the Winfield Fire Hall from 7-12. Fall Baseball Clinic is being held, see attached flyer.
- Basketball: Last registration this week. Coaches Clinic on October 6. Will have clinics for players. Travel Basketball will start in the next few weeks. Jean has given cheer gym time at LSE.
- Football: ½ way through the season. Weather has caused changes. Capital Landscaping has done a wonderful Job for the program this year. Q: When is trash pick-up at Mayeski and where should they put bags? A: pick-up is Monday and bags should go in the dumpster. Q: coach that works at Verizon wants to give bonus to program, but needs tax id. A: tax id was sent to secretary already.
- Lacrosse: 1st day of evaluations were last Sunday. They will have one more this Sunday and the rain date will be the following weekend. Shortly there after will be open registration.
- Softball: In-house is resting peacefully until next season. CML has finished try-outs they will have 1 team for 10U and 14U and two teams for 12U and 16U. STARS will have 1- 12U and 14U and 2- 18U teams. They have started practice. They need to work on indoor time.
- New Business: Policy for Portable Units – Karen feels WRC should provide Port-A-Pots for fields that our programs use. Loren will look into this for local schools, LSE and Winfield. All programs that use these facilities will take care of ordering Potties and then send the bill to Karen. Motion was made for WRC to pay for the Potties for programs as needed and was 2nd all were in favor.
- Community Representative: Still waiting on the BOE. She is on their agenda for Recommendations. Another 50 to 60 thousand still needs to be raised. See the attached fliers for fundraisers.
