Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis

Minutes from the March meeting were accepted with the correction that Tim Brown (football/cheer) attended the March mtg but was not listed . Jackie noted that all future certificate of insurance issued by the county will no require 7-10 days notice, please plan ahead.

Treasurer: \$8385.00 in acct for WRC and \$7119.00 in acct for Basketball. Reminder to all programs that expense and figures are to be submitted monthly, received only FB/CL. Baseball and Softball owe the \$300. admin fee and \$2.00 per player fee.

President:

1. It's being considered that our council merge with the Woodbine rec council. Woodbine has only adult activities. Much like Pleasant Valley and Charles Carroll, Taneytown and West Carroll, Union Bridge and New Windsor. To better serve the community
2. County has purchased property on Woodbine Road for a new park, construction to begin July 2003.
