

WRC Meeting Minutes
April 27, 2009

Presidents Report: Minutes from March 09 were approved. Ed explained that he is now president of the CARC. Field space is an issue within our organization. Ed would like to establish a committee to come up with a proposal, which will meet the needs of the WRC and the cost of the finished project, to take to the county.
