Gary Davis called the meeting to order. The minutes from the 06/25/01 meeting were accepted and approved by the board.

- Treasurer:**
1. \$11,245.00 in account
 2. Need from Soccer: \$300.00 admin fee, proposed budget
 3. Need from Wrestling: \$2.00 per player fee, \$100.00 admin fee and proposed budget
 4. Need from Football: \$2.00 per player fee
 5. Gary noted the increase in BG&E bill August/July is from electric well pump because HS water's their field.
 6. Carol received a Thank you for donation in name of Nancy Stocksdale.
 7. Quarterly Treasurer's report to be turned into Carol each quarter. Failure to comply will result in loss of facility permits
- Jeff Degitz:
1. Self help project money requests are due by 9/7/01 (75% county and 25% program) Gary noted Linton Springs PTSO has asked for us to sponsor a playground if we have no other project request.
 2. County Tobacco Products Use Guidelines was given out to all programs. Use of tobacco products prohibited within 50 yards of playing field or program site.
 3. Century HS facility usage: No one allowed on school outside facilities (2BB and 1 SB field) this year and it will be re-evaluated in fall for spring usage. Inside facilities limited to both gyms and wrestling room, due to limited custodians staff. Gyms 6-9 M-Th and 6 hours on Saturday 9-3 – No Sunday or Fridays. Usage is 50/50 split Freedom/Winfield until new middle school is built.
 4. It was requested that Sykesville Middle be included in our schools for flyers.
- Wrestling:
1. Expressed concern with across the board growth and having the usage of facilities taken away. Concerns with the 6 hours on Saturday at Century not enough time to do tournaments. It was noted that principals have final ruling on use of facilities. If it's a school function, it's priority. If the facility is permitted for school functions and not being used, it was noted to document and we can approach the school.
 2. Registration next month, planning meeting next month.
 3. Hope to get more home matches

4. Wants to purchase mats, must cure and lay flat 2 weeks (need place)
Will get with Gary.
 2. Have a league mtg. on 9/8 and would like to have facility dates at that time. Gyms not available at Century until after 12/1
- Football:
1. Tim noted would like to apply for self help money to finish field on top of hill. Tim will get w/ Jeff to survey field.
 2. Football Jamboree on 8/18 was a Hugh Success. Had over 6000 people here. Tim thanked all who participated and thanked Gary for working with SC. Tim noted that parking was a problem and next year intend to get fire department volunteers to help w/ parking, state police and highway administration to help with routing cars.
 3. Inc program size this year, approximately 125 Cheer and 200 FB
- Soccer:
1. Registrations went well and have started program
- Aerobics:
1. Noted programs starts 9/13 and still need to know about facility use. Patti will check. Kathy asked if the custodians could pick up tables only have facility for 1hr.
- Softball:
1. Program Done. In-house went well and 2 teams to Nationals in NC
 2. Would like to know if any gym time available for pitching clinics. Our programs is known as up and coming program in region. Would like to try to get some professional coaches. Only work with 4 players at a time for maximum teaching.
- Square Dance:
1. SC is a go. If can't use cafeteria, can use lobby.
 2. Sam noted that Westminster and NC Program recently closed, possibly due to lack of facility. However there were 100 people at the last dance.
- Baseball:
1. Still need to resolve field at Linton, it belongs to Freedom and they don't want to develop it.
 2. Need another 90' diamond
 3. Wanted to resolve roomers that baseball is out of money. All bills have been paid and because they did not do fund-raiser, they are a little tight on money.
 4. Issue of loaning equipment was discussed and Greg noted that the baseball board had voted not to allow other programs use their equipment because it was returned broken. Gary said if anyone uses another programs' piece of equipment and it is returned broken, have equipment repaired and send other program bill.
- Gary Davis:
1. Fogle's Potty Service has a contract with the County and therefore, the county strongly suggest we use their pots. If additional ones are needed, call Mike Whitson at county first.
 2. Two of the bleaches used by football, belong to the soccer field.
 3. Still looking to start a lacrosse program – need someone to coach and organize
