7. Aerobics program had continuous problems with getting facility time and space and is no longer doing program.
8. Winfield continues to expand with no added fields, after much discussion, it was suggested to Bill Schaefer that line be drawn at Linton Springs for Freedom and Winfield Rec. Bill will try to resolve and let us know.
