Summer Programs Overview:

Carol Michael – Martial Arts: Is a continuous program of 15-25 students consisting of children, teens, and adults. Winfield has been very cooperative in past years. Uses Winfield elementary gym from June 17-August 21 on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 5:45-8:15.

Brenda Stremer – Field Hockey: 8th year for program. Program will run from June 17-July 16 on Tuesday and Thursdays. They will have 10 games in 5 weeks and will end with a tournament. Participants will be incoming 9th graders-12 grade. Also asked permission to hold clinics for elementary and middle school students and was approved. Recommendations were made by Barbara and Ed on how to handle monies. Checks need to be made out to WRC for liability reasons.

Ashley Bacon – Field Hockey: Wants to hold a clinic for 3rd-8th grade students from July 7-11 from 9AM-12PM. Seniors will volunteer to work the camp with her. This was approved and she was told to follow the same guidelines as Brenda. She was also recommended to make field request with Dave ASAP.

Lisa Piecewicz – Summer Playground: Program has existed for 18 years. It runs from June 23-27 and July 28-August 1st from 9:30AM- 3PM at Winfield Elementary School. There are approximately 20 children per session ages K-5th. The cost is \$90.00.

Approval of Minutes: Jenn Schneider – January 2008 minutes were reviewed and approved by board.

Nominations: Ed Beane was officially voted in as President for a two year term and Jenn Schneider was officially voted in as secretary for a two year term.

Treasurer's Report: Karen Wootton – \$16,159 in checking and \$7291.00 in savings. Wrestling assessment issues were addressed. Noted to review annual budget in June.

Department of Recreation: Self Help proposals will be reviewed Wednesday, February 27. The Code of Conduct Review meeting will be February 26 and a revised county version will be coming out.

Baseball: Registration is complete and they have approximately 300 participants. Practices will start the week of March 17 and games will begin on April 12.

Athletic Director: Jim Horn – The new addition is coming, construction will begin on July 16. The High School will be loosing their JV football field and back parking lot. Due to renovations the high school will need to share field space at Mayeski for this year.

Basketball: Jean Shea – Couple of weeks left, March 15th is the end of their season. They are possibly going to hold two camps at South Carroll, Doug Golff Varsity Coach at SC will attend next meeting. The Daddy Daughter Dance will be held May 2nd.

Softball: 139 in-house registered. Fundraisers: Basket Bingo, March 8th at the Gamber Fire Hall. 5K race on April 5th starting at Century High School. Lotto Fundraiser during the month of April.

Soccer: Permits – games are not scheduled until last week in April. UK Elite is interested in doing a camp the last week in July-1st week in August. He will attend next meeting to present their plan. Outdoor soccer is starting shortly and will be splitting time between Winfield and Linton.

Lacrosse: Fred Wells – Everything going well.

Football and Cheer: Registration dates are April 19 for returning players and open registration is April 26 and May 3rd. Registration will take place in the South Carroll Cafeteria from 9AM-12PM.

Wrestling: Finishing up their season. They will be holding a camp at McDaniel College the same week the Ravens hold their training camp.

Gymnastics: Spring session starts on April 9 at Winfield Elementary and will run for 8 weeks. The cost is \$65.00. The summer program will start mid to late July and will run from 9-12 PM the 1st week and 1-3 PM the 2nd week the cost for this program will be \$85. Advertisements are coming. April 11 is the Golf tournament for the MD Stars.

New Business: Judy Bullock – The Rec Council voted to donated \$100.00 to the Athletes with Special Needs Program. Fred wants to discuss field issues at the next meeting. Ed said their needs to be a special work meeting separate from Rec Council Meeting to discuss these issues and Buddy was put in charge.
