Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis. Minutes from the 11/26/01 meeting were accepted and approved by the board.

Treasurer Report: \$23,768.00 in account Need ¼ reports from football and wrestling.

Gary Davis: 1. Welcomed Bill Schaefer. Noted Bill will be attending mtg instead of Jeff Degitz.

Bill Schaefer:

1. Bill will handle scheduling at Linton Springs and Century. Use of facility forms will still go to Patti first.
2. There are 4 available fields at century, fall of 2002
3. Bill will represent both Winfield and Freedom and will continue to work with Gary to have programs work together. Winfield allowed Freedom to use fields for lax and gym time.
4. Self help project has been approved for upper field.
5. Freedom will develop baseball/softball diamond at Linton
6. Rec councils have 50% of Century, we share that with Freedom 25/25.
7. Expect time at Century to grow, possibly gain Sundays.

Wrestling:

1. Steve noted that Freedom hasn't helped the wrestling program in the last 5 years since he has been involved.
2. In the event of an emergency, use of facility – who should they call?? It was noted they should have a copy of the use of facility form as proof.
3. Tournament 2/16 and 2/17 8am – 8pm @ Linton
4. Problem with custodians– if not there at noon (on the dot) they leave and program has no access to facility. Custodians start at 8am and should start at noon, if programs can't use until noon.

- Football/Cheer
1. Has started the self help project process, gaining bids for the county
 2. Football Jamboree is August 17, request for entire park (soccer and high school practice field)
 3. Plan to redo football field with top-soil and hydro-seed.
 4. Again propose to work out scheduling plan with soccer to use soccer field for practice Tues and Thur (after daylight savings) in exchange for football field during away Saturday games.
 5. Was requested by WRC that new sea containers be secured and painted by 5/18 softball tournament
- Softball
1. Bill S. will put in work order to repair back strip and fencing, repair rail road ties around fields 1,2,and 3 @ Mayeski
 2. Current registration – 60 girls inhouse (1 more registration date) 1 – 12 and under, 1 – 14 and under, 2 – 16 and under, 1-18 and under, plus 4 central MD teams
 3. Will host tournament 5/18 and 5/19 @ Mayeski and Sports Complex
 4. Winfield Classic tournament 7/5, 7/6 and 7/7 @ Mayeski
 5. Request Saturday permits for 6 weeks, pitching clinic
 6. Many lights out at Mayeski, Gary to work on
