

Winfield Recreation Council --- January 26, 2004

Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis
Minutes from the November meeting were accepted and approved by board

Regular mtg set aside to have 2004 elections:

Jackie Wright as Secretary for the 2005 and 2005 term
Elections in 2005 for Vice President and treasurer.

Reminder that all programs should submit invoices to Carol for payment. All checks should be payable to WRC.

Wrestling owes \$100 admin fee, plus \$2.00 per player

Basketball will provide # of players to transfer \$2.00 per player to WRC account

Lacrosse as a new program was exempt from the \$300 admin fee and \$2.00 per player for this first season

BG&E cost was decided to split the football/soccer time 75%FB / 25% soccer – Fall soccer bills given to football \$803.43 and soccer \$267.81 – remit pmts direct to Carol

President: County self help \$\$ deadline was extended to 2/6/04. Lacrosse will submit for a new storage container and helmet racks, total \$7500.00. Soccer to submit for park fencing.

Basketball: In-season. Last game is 3/13 will have pizza and trophies after final game. Travel BB doing well, have 4 teams by grade for boys and 3 teams for girls.

Wrestling: In-season. Have 5 teams, had a few snowed out tournaments. Big Warrior tournament upcoming @ McDonough

Football/Cheer: Have elections for 2004 board next month, don't expect any major changes. FB/CL having a bull roast @ Winfield on 4/17. Will have more information @ next months mtg. For tickets contact Sheryl Harrison @ (410) 549-5566. Expect to add another I70 team next year and will need additional field/practice space.

Lacrosse: Pre-season. Currently have 321 players. 19 teams -- 148 girls and 178 boys and 40 coaches and asst coaches committed for the spring season
Currently holding an indoor clinic at Nothing But Air for the month of February, cost of \$25.00 per camper. Recd permits to have sock hop @ SC on 3/26, 4/30 and waiting on approval of 5/14, Awaiting permits to use fields behind tennis courts, inside track @ SC and practice area around the outshirts of Mayeski. Dan Knott @ Soccer has offered the use of the upper Linton field as a game field, M-F and Saturday, soccer will need it on Sunday for games. Pineapple ask if possible to use the football and/or soccer lighted

fields for a “few” games, Gary said he’d get back with him on that. Bill reminder program to submit coaches/volunteer registration forms.
