**Secretary:** Minutes from the 11/28/05 meeting were accepted and approved

**WRC Treasurer:**

Current balances: \$23,784 WRC in checking and \$7087 in savings.  
Wrestling owes administration fee and \$2.00 per player; BB owes administration fee and \$2.00 per player.

**Program Treasurer:** Gary submitted repair field lights in the amount \$3940.00 to Jean to pay and transfer any monies between accounts.

**President:** Gary informed the board that Bill Shaffer's mom recently passed away, our thoughts and prayers are with him. Patty will send something on behalf of our board.

Gary welcomed all back and congratulated Westminster and South Carroll Football Teams for making it to the State Championship this year.

Grant to install fence around Mayeski Park has been denied. Gathering data on field vandalism and costs to repair field to reapply to county for help. Arbitration of 2 girls found guilty of vandalizing fields resulted in fine and community service hours. Also working on getting prices on installing mercury lights, possibly signs as deterrents.

**Elections:** President and Secretary are up for 2 year elections terms. Gary made motion to nominate Jackie as secretary, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave, accepted and approved by board. Gary made motion to nominate Dave Taylor as President, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Jean, accepted and approved

by board. Gary will sit as Vice President for Dave's remaining 1 year term. Next January the VP and Treasurer positions are up for election

**Lacrosse:** Currently have 295 players registered for the spring and 132 registered for the clinic @ Nothing But Air. Registration is slightly lower than last year and could be result of early tryouts. Will continue in the MYLA. WRC will continue to handle funds again this year. **Softball:** Registration doing well with inhouse. Along with 7 MD Stars teams and 2 CM teams, expect to have an 18<sup>^</sup> team this year to play in tournaments. 3/11 is set for field day; softball begins end of March. Tournaments @ Mayeski: 5/20 & 5/21; 7/8 and 7/9; 7/15 and 7/16.

**Baseball:** Rick advised recd ltr from attorney who owns property behind Lions and said they'll be ok this year; however, they may loose parking area due to development. We anticipate Krimgold will be on board next year and allow us playing fields. Registration #'s are up, possibly to do aggressive advertising.
