Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis.

Minutes from February mtg, accepted and approved by the board with the correction under new business that soccer will use the SC field behind the tennis courts on Saturday and Sunday.

Treasurer:

1. \$7546.09 in WRC account and \$8568.69 in Basketball account.
2. All programs are current w/ BG&E expenses.
3. SB and BB owe the \$300.00 admin fee along with the \$2.00 per player.

Gary:

1. Gary advised all programs that the WRC board is responsible for the inc/exp of all programs. Each program attending received a copy of the current WRC bylaws. Therefore starting with the April mtg, all programs will include in their monthly report the income and expense for their program as of that date. **Lack of reporting and attendance to the monthly WRC mtgs will result in lose of facility permits.**
2. Reminded all programs we are “nonprofit” and should not have excess money at season end, unless for “special projects”.
3. Gary replaced locks on WRC container (old one wouldn’t lock)
4. Volunteer forms must be completed and turned in prior to season start. Jackie will request a current list from County and email to all programs

Patti:

1. Patti will get school emails to try to get information in monthly newsletters and see if we could advertise @ Winfield Marquee. (Maybe have Easter Egg Hunt at Winfield Elementary.

FB/CL:

1. Pre-registration is 4/26 @ Mayeski (returning players) Other registration dates 5/3, 5/10, 5/31, 6/7.

2. With new I-70 B Level – projected 500 players
3. New Board Members: Wendi Driver @ Treasurer; Sheryl and Ron Harrison as Concession.
4. Currently working on 2003 season budget (major emphasis on equipment and fields) Last year large expense on equipment due to adding two new fb teams @ I-70 level.
5. 2003 projects:
 - a. press box – finish up w/ roof, decking and safety rails.
 - b. hope to get electric to containers this year w/ future score board.
6. Need upper field. FB program is growing and expanding, don't want to slow that process. We have 5/7 home games a year. Would like to see soccer/football work together for maximum use of park. Football has already gone to split practice nights due to the size of the program
7. Football to start practice on 7/26
8. FB Jamboree is 8/16

- Basketball:**
1. Preparing budget for next year
 2. Gathering information for a possible self help project @ Century
 3. Looking to do spring league 9 – 12th graders
 4. Would like to do summer league – but can't get gym time

- Soccer:**
1. Year End banquet went well
 2. Linton Spring field is being used by Century players. Soccer spent money and time on Linton fields and Century plowed snow off field and damaged fields. (need to put estimate repair cost to approach Century for repairs.
 3. Soccer has had to chase Freedom Lax off the soccer fields the last 2 weekends
 4. Registration for fall is 1st 3 Saturdays in May
 5. Plan coaches mtg in April, will get w/ Patti for use of SC Media
 6. Few spring teams already started

- Baseball:**
1. Registration down slightly this year @ 325 players
 2. Field Day 4/12
 3. Opening Day 4/26, will extend season by 2 weeks
 4. May do a Championship Day at end of season

- Softball:**
