Meeting was called to order by Dave Taylor @ 7:15pm

Secretary: Minutes from the February 26, 2007 mtg were approved by the board

Ed made motion to set aside regular mtg format to hear from guests, 2nd by Jackie and approved.

Mike Krause of CC Cannons spoke about new semi-pro team and requested use of a regulation football field for home games. Ed made motion to allow CC Cannons become an affiliate of WRC, 2nd by Jackie and approved. Cannons will pay \$2.00 per player and \$300 admin fee. Baseball will do concession. Dave will check to see if they can use the field inside track @ SC for home games. In the event of bad weather, Bud Brown will make call on field.

Phil Brudner of Perfect Balance is gymnastics (power tumbling for cheer, dance, stunt and cheer) been in business for 27 years, ages 4 -13. He would like to request indoor time to hold summer clinic 9-noon once a week. He has his own insurance.

Approved by board if indoor time is available. Dave Taylor will get w/ Phil about time and locations.

Treasurer: \$22,000 in account. Karen is working on budget items. Baseball expects to pay (\$5000 as well as 06/07 and 07/08 fees) by 4/1. Budget items due June 07: FB \$800; Soccer \$800; Softball \$800; Lacrosse \$500. All summer camp funds should be payable to WRC and submitted to treasurer.

Coordinator: Dave advised mtg on Krimgold people voiced same concerns with noise, trash and parking. Ed made motion, 2nd by Bud to get resolution on Krimgold. (Approved) Dave will talk w/ advisory board. Dave will follow-up with Barb on Mayeski Paving.

Field Coordinator: Buddy needs key #15 for concession. Installed drain tile on access road.

Baseball: 335 players, 31 teams in rec league, 3 travel teams in Babe Ruth and Ripkin leagues. Expect to hold lottery fundraiser, 6/1 Golf tournament and 4/21 Pepsi Pitch, hit and run @ Lions Club – no fee

Basketball: season over. SC Varsity Coach Dough Geoff to hold BB camp over summer

FB/CL: Post season cheer teams placed 1st and 2nd at last competition. Just had elections and having trouble obtaining paperwork from former cheer AD. Brd suggested to recreate forms. FB/CL registration upcoming in April. Jeff apologize for concession and work will hard to resolve issued next year.

Lacrosse: Season begins this week. Expect to use SCHS girls hockey field and boys upper field @ Mayeski as game fields. Expect to spend \$20,000 for helmets, shirts and gloves this year.

Soccer: Spring season has begun. 4/16 is spring brd mtg and will vote new brd members. Registration dates have been submitted. Dan thanked everyone for their thoughts and kind words after his dad's passing.

Softball: Glen advised the accelerate your game speed camp registration form has been posted online. No more than 50, but could have 2nd session if #'s permit. Inhouse softball has 139 girls with 13 teams. Field day is Sat. Every team has sponsor and plan to hold pitching clinic on Sunday.

Wrestling: 1st place in Mid MD Regionals. Planning end of season banquet and will have August planning mtg.

Old Business:

Tractor: After discussion, Jackie made motion to expend \$6000 to purchase tractor, 2nd by Gary and approved

Paving: After discussion, Jackie made motion to expend \$6000 to move forward with self help paving, 2nd by Gary and approved.

New Business:

Jim Carnes (teacher and coach @ SC) was involved in auto accident. He expects to be home next week

Ronnie Legore Activities Park: Non-profit organization formed in memory of Ronnie, who lived and worked in Winfield for the 49 years until his death in 2002. Buddy submitted letter from Wanda Legore on behalf committee advising they have set aside funds to build a 300' ballfield.
