Approval of Minutes: Jenn Schneider – February 2008 minutes were reviewed and approved by board.

Treasurer's Report: Karen Wootton – \$18,048.23 in checking and \$7291.00 in savings. Scholarships, is this in the works? Get Dave to report next month.

Department of Recreation: Self Help was approved for Infield mix for softball and baseball. Bi-laws are all set except basketball and square dance. Barbara requested moving meetings to the cafeteria for easier access.

Field Coordinator: There was a great turn out for Field Day. The baseball diamond was approved for field #4. The gate was delivered it will be installed soon. Gates will be installed where all cable entrances are at Mayeski Park. A request to rent a roller for \$250.00 to be shared by football and softball to roll the fields was approved. It was noted that Century High was offered the use of the roller, free of charge, and declined due to lack of time. Bud is going to come up with a plan and proposed cost to add more fields to Mayeski to accommodate the growing organization. This will be discussed further when he gets more information.

Baseball: Registration is complete and they have approximately 325 participants. They will be fielding 4 travel teams. These are Ripkin travel teams that play Rec/Travel Ball. Season starts April 7. They will have 4-10 year old teams participating in the Parade set for April 26. April 26 will also be there picture day and Pitch, Hit, and Run. Fundraisers they are doing: Lottery raffle tickets, Bull roast, and Golf outing. See attached

Basketball: Jean Shea and Doug Goff, Varsity Basketball coach for SC – dates for his camp are June 16-20 for students entering 4th-6th grades, July 7-11 for students entering 7th-9th.

Softball: Basket Bingo profited 9,000. The Lotto ticket fund raiser goes through the month of May. The 5K race will be held on April 5 and the Golf outing will be the following week. They cleaned the floor in the Linton Springs community room and it looks great. Softball would like to request to use the Fields at Mayeski for their tryouts on Sunday, August 10th and 17th and May 17th and 18th for their May Madness. They have already coordinated this with Baseball and they can use all but the 30 ft Diamond. They gave them Linton and Century for Mayeski.

Soccer: Field day went well. Getting roller and dirt for Linton Springs so they may need the tractor. Everything is coming along well.

Lacrosse: Concerns on field space at Mayeski and South Carroll with his growing program. He would like to open his own account for Lacrosse program sometime before September. See attached

Football and Cheer: Registration dates are April 19 for returning players and open registration is April 26 and May 3rd. Registration will take place in the South Carroll Cafeteria from 9AM-12PM.
