Meeting was called to order by Dave Taylor. Minutes from 4/24/06 meeting were approved.

Reports:

Treasurer: \$22519.49 in checking, \$7225 in savings.
Baseball and Softball owe \$300 administrative fee and \$2/player fee

Wrestling: Behind on reports, will catch up as soon as possible. Patti needs the key to the community room at Linton from Steve. Lisa will relay message.

Soccer: Registration is finished, try-outs for travel to begin shortly. Numbers down a little but Kathleen expects to pick up more players as the summer progresses. Some adjustments have been made to the fields. There is still concern re: the damage done by the carnival and the fire department's refusal to help repair. Dave relayed that the fire dept. will be having carnival people sign contract this year to repair any damage and if they don't, fire dept. agrees to repair.

Football/

Cheer: Registration is finished, numbers are up for both football and cheer. Space/equipment are potential issues due to increased size. Football will ask AD, Jim Horn, about the possibility of using field hockey and softball fields for cheering practice to free up space for football practice. Some damage noted to new field (tire tracks).

Lock was replaced on one of the containers by rec due to some property damage. Financial reports to be sent as soon as new treasurer finishes them. Football voted to support a post-season cheer competition team. Bull roast

at Mt. Airy Firehall Aug. 18th. Golf tournament at Challedon Sept. 15th.

Lacrosse: Currently \$16000 in treasury. Fran will check budget to see if they had intended to pay the \$300 admin. fee and the \$2/player fee this year. Several girls teams going to playoffs, all teams doing very well, several undefeated. Really pushing the concept of learning the game. Lax offered to handle maintenance of high school field hockey field in return for girls being allowed to use it after 5/15 for playoffs but Jim Horn refused. Still scrounging for fields. Soccer field still has major rivets from last season. Lax is offering manpower and some funds to help repair but it needs to be done within the next 10 days. Two goals were inadvertently not put away and were run over. They are unsalvageable, but the nets can be repaired. Sock hop had good turn out, profit of \$700. Fran thanked Susie for running it. Attempts have been made to extend fund-raising efforts beyond just coaches, etc. Suggestion was made that registration rates be raised and a mandatory \$30-\$40 fund-raising fee be added to free up coaches from fund-raising work.

Baseball: Cars were being parked on new field, Ed Garber handled it well. Fencing should solve some of the field issues. Discussion ensued regarding driving on the fields and it was agreed that coaches need to set the example. There was also some discussion re: providing handicapped access. Council needs to find out if they are required to offer same. Playoffs start 6/3, with some travel teams going until 7/4. Baseball is on budget. Needs copy of insurance certificate, was directed where to get it. Drainage problem at Century field, Baseball would like to correct if possible and budget permits. Advised to discuss with AD and proceed from there. Two teams interested in fall ball, would like to see about possibility of fields. Baseball will start by checking with Century.

Softball: In-house had parade, Dave presented fire dept. with certificate of appreciation for their participation. Hopefully this will help to repair relationship with dept. Select teams doing well, earning 4-5 first place trophies. Former rec ball player is a player on a Div. II National Championship team. May Madness went well, with 48 teams and 119 games. This was also held at Carroll Co. Sports Complex and Glen was disturbed by the poor condition of both the fields and facilities there. Gary will take this concern to the county rec meeting on 5/24/06. Glen will work on fall field permits, coordinating with Football. Would also like to use Century and will go directly to Bill for permits. Softball wants to run a recruiting seminar and needs an auditorium, will go through Patti for permit. Ed B. thanks Dave for his efforts with building bridges with the fire department, and Baseball for sharing fields for tournaments.

Coordinator: Looking for field for field hockey camp for 7/17-20, 7/31, 8/2. Soccer fields available for all but 8/2, Softball available 7/31. Suggestion was made to check Salt Box Park and Patti will check that out as a possibility.

Other: Gary will ask at county meeting on 5/24 about status of Krimgold Park. Gary will also address possibility of adding to 5-yr. plan a completely refurbished concession stand. Also possible as a self-help project. Fence estimate is a bit lower than originally thought, is now about \$12,900. Rec will pay \$5000, Basketball generously offered \$2000 and Baseball, Softball, Soccer, Lax, and Football/Cheer agree to split the remainder, about \$1180 per program. Rec will pay upfront and programs will reimburse. County will supply locks for the fence. Contract was signed and Carol will fax to contractor 5/23/06.
