

**WRC Meeting Minutes**  
May 24, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7:04 p.m. by President Ed Beane.

**Presidents Report:** Minutes for April 13th were approved. Informed board of WRC Scholarship presentation at senior awards night is June 3<sup>rd</sup> for South Carroll HS and Century HS is scheduled for June 1st. Ed introduced the residents of the Streaker Road project, the area in which WRC wants to create practice field space for Lacrosse and soccer. Then Karl King was asked to give an explanation of the project. Karl explained to the home owners that we are still working on ways to provide more field space at Mayeski but we have expanded Mayeski as far as we can at this time. Then Karl gave an over view of what WRC expectations are for the Streaker Road Project. Questions, concerns, and answers were shared by all through discussion between community and WRC members. Community members voiced concerns regarding increased traffic, property values and noise. One resident was upset that he was only hearing about the project now (i.e., May 2010), but that the county proposed WRC use of the property in November 2009. Ed suggested WRC thought it was important to obtain community input from abutters. And that he is responsible for the delay from November until now to provide notice. Abutters thanked the council for conducting the meeting and indicated they would meet to discuss how they would address concerns to Recreation and Parks staff.

**Treasurer's report:** Karen will e-mail the treasurers report.

**Department of Recreation and Parks:** Thanks to the WRC for supporting the Tournament of Champions at McDaniel. 85 students participated in this tournament and WRC gave \$150 for 3 children. Discussed the discounted tickets for Amusement Parks that are offered through the county. Thank you for getting information in about summer camps and clinics. The county will only pay for Spot-A-Pots on park sites not school sights.

**County Coordinator:** Scholarship candidates have been chosen. End of the year reports will be submitted to the county at the end of June so please make sure all reports are up to date and accurate.

**Lacrosse:** 5 teams are left in the playoffs and then summer leagues will begin.

**Football/Cheer:** Will hold another Open registration on June 5 from 9-12 at Mayeski Park. We will be sending another phone blast to inform the community about the WYFCP program.

**Soccer:** Had on-line registration and numbers are about the same as last year. High school tryouts for girls' soccer will be held at Mayeski all other high school try outs will take place on school grounds. Patty will forward the e-mail she received from Jim with the dates and times.
