Treasurer report:

3. BB has offered to donate \$1000 from funds to WRC

4. Upper field (self help project) Bill Schaefer said working with BPR to reduce their fee to do work. Should have figures and be able to begin in mid January.
5. Gary wants metal poles removed and suggested renting a vibratory roller and reseed field for next season.
