Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis.

Minutes from the September meeting were accepted and approved by board.

Lacrosse: Bill okayed registration forms. Registration dates 12/6, 12/13, 1/10 @ South Carroll Lobby. Would like to submit for self help money for goals, storage container etc.

Basketball: Basketball season teams are picked and ready to begin. With the SC Aux gym closed, need more space. Patti to call and see if Mt. Airy Middle is available
