Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis

Minutes from 9/23/02 meeting were accepted by board

Treasurer: \$11,430.16 in account.

Gary noted our big issue (as always) is facility time. Century adjusted and gave us Sunday noon-6pm and Saturdays 2-6:30pm. However, no additional time during the weeknights. Bill advised use of facilities has been problem with all rec councils. Schools have new administrators and they need to be educated by Dept of Rec. On schools with custodial shortages, option to allow rec council brd member have key. If programs are not going to use facilities, notify school to eliminate unnecessary custodial staff.

With limited facilities, programs may need to put cap on registrations County purchased land on Rt 94 for a multi purpose park to be shared Woodbine, Winfield & Freedom. This project is 5 years away.

One major complaint, at Linton and South Carroll, from the board of education is the lack of supervision of siblings during events/practices. They are allowed to run up and down the hallways. If this continues to happen, the responsible program will loose use of facilities.

Request of facilities time was also discussed. Programs expect to have acknowledgement that request was received within 2 days of submitting and a determination and/or copy of permit within 2 weeks. Bill will review this procedure with Patty. It was noted that all requests, must be made in writing to Patty, cc: Bill, Gary and Jeff. School brd is working on a major use of facilities software, the one Dave proposed was not compatible with their software.
