Meeting called to order by President, Gary Davis

Minutes from the September 27th meeting were accepted and approved by board.

Jackie asked that everyone send her any information on where and how they advertise for free and she will compile list of name and contacts, ie "Get in the Game"

Treasurer: no report

President: Gary mentioned 2 positions are up for nominations for a 2 year term. Treasurer and Vice President. Due to this mtg not being regular scheduled mtg, brd decided to take nominations for these positions but table until next week. Ed nominated Dave Taylor as Vice President, Dave accepted. It was mentioned we thought Carol would continue as treasurer if no one else was interested.

The Winfield Rec Council Volunteer of the Year nomination was Wayne Walhouse. It was noted that even with battling cancer, he continues to coach softball. He's a great guy. What a great nomination. Volunteer of the year is a one year event. Gary mentioned the parking across from SC High Stadium needs to be addressed, Bill said he'd talk to school.

Patty Taylor: Thanks all that helped set up and take down the voting booths. WRC will receive a \$130 donation for that few hours of work. Patty passed out use of facility permits. **Winter School Newsletter will go out to the school in January, the deadline to get Patty information for that Newsletter is November 30th**

Dave Taylor: Email addresses are growing thanks to input and updates from each program. Dave will create spreadsheet to help calculate volunteer hours.

Bill Schaefer: Passed out annual 2004 report. It was discussed that there should be a mathematical equation based on # of players vs # of playing fields to determine what programs have field privileges. It was noted that Freedom program has luxury of having a separate "game" field. It was discussed that # of volunteer hours for the Winfield Program is grossly under-estimated. Dave will develop form to help program heads better calculate hours for next year.

All self help projects were approved. However, the project of paving the front lot has been put on hold to see if any other money is available in February to do more of the lot.

Soccer: by Saturday 11/13 most of soccer will be completed. Kathleen thanked football for the use of the sound system and working together for the best interest of the children.

Lacrosse: Pre-registration for returning players is 11/20. Open registration is 12/4, 12/11 and 12/18 10-2pm @ South Carroll Lobby. With the concern for field again this year, Lax feels if they limit registration. The players that get turned away will only go to the Freedom program. Why not let the players play in their own back yard and adjust the field usage accordingly. It was noted that the field on Old Liberty Road is used only for a girls GAME field, why not share that field between Freedom and Winfield. Bill said he would set up meeting with Freedom and Winfield to discuss these field issues prior to the start of the spring outdoor sports. Fred wanted to confirm that Lacrosse was a spring

sport and based on prior meeting, would take preference over a non-spring sport, such as soccer when permitting for outdoor fields. Indoor clinic @ NBA in January.

Baseball: Have a few positions on their board open. Registrations dates are 1/8, 1/22, 1/29, 2/5 10-2 pm @ South Carroll Lobby.

Softball: Same registration dates as baseball 1/8, 1/22, 1/29, 2/5 10-2 @ South Carroll Lobby. Opening Day parade will be 1st Saturday in May. Ernie Parker is holding a pitching clinic @ Century, contact Gary for more information
