Department of Recreation: Barbara Lages - Nothing to report

County Coordinator: Dave Taylor – Not present – It was discussed that the board review the Bylaws Article VI sections 2 and 3 and discuss program activity and financial reports as old business for next month. Jenn was given an action item to amend error in WRC Bylaws.

Field Coordinator: Bud Brown - Tractor is out of order, the belt on the mower deck is broke. The bill for the repair will be shared. Breakers, at Mayeski, have been replaced by the county. All lights will also be repaired.

Football/Cheer: Bud Brown - Everything is good. Few teams going to the playoffs. Cheer did merge with MMFCL. The Cheer competition will be on November 2nd at the Ag Center in Westminster.

WCCS: Terri Aiosa – Cheer Director for WCCS – They have held their registration and have 21 girls from 1st through 8th grade. They have to combine teams because they did not have enough elementary enrollments. Practice starts the 1st week in December and will go through May if they qualify for Final Destination. If they do not qualify they will end in April. All monies from the fundraisers did not go into the program they went toward the girls uniforms. They will also be holding two sock hops on December 5th and January 31st at the Freedom Optimist to raise monies to help with the total cost for the girls. Their first competition will be in January. It was suggested by Karen that WCCS do all their finances through WYFCP, not independently. Due to this an action item was given to Jenn to get 42.00 check to Laurie, treasurer WYFCP, who will in return write a check to the WRC for the \$ 2 per child fee.

Soccer: Patty Schneider – this is the last week of regular games. Travel will be playing through the end of November and Patty wants to make sure they will have proper lighting until then. Randy Penz, AD Century – Questioned why there is no one using the fields and it was noted because they want the fields to rest/offline as they do in the spring. There will be no club banquet they have opted to have individual team parties.
