Minutes from the 8/26/02 meeting were accepted by board

Treasurer: \$12689.66 in account. Soccer owes \$2.00 per player and \$300 administration fee. Wrestling owes \$2.00 per player and \$100.00 administration fee. Still need revenue and expense reports from Soccer, FB and Wrestling (07/1/01 – 06/30/02)

Greg Mihalko from South Carroll HS (basketball and football) did presentation and would like to have a non-contact football camp and a basketball camp next summer.

BB: 6/24 – 6/27 9am – 1pm girls camp, 6/17 – 6/20 9am – 1pm boys camp.

Softball: Had a good turnout on tryouts for tournament teams the last 2 weeks. Submitted for self help (9/25) to replace all backstops on field #1,2 and 3. Remove and replace entire fence, due to safety issues and add fencing behind the benches. These can easily be covered w/ tarps during the summer months for shade. Total project \$24,900. Program commitment \$9,000.

Sq Dance: Still awaiting permits for SC on Tuesdays. Program was refused use by custodians last Tuesday because of no form. Patti with check w/ Eric and let Sam know.

Basketball: Registrations are scheduled for next week, anticipate 350 players. This year Don hoped to reduce the size of the teams to allow maximum play

the time for each player and start a girl's league. With the schools reducing gym time from last year, this may not be possible. Still have not received any commitment of time from South Carroll or Winfield Elem. After a discussion, it was agreed Gary should talk w/ Gary Horst, Jean will email Dr. Ecker and the entire brd of education. Jean and/or Gary will invite the brd of education members and the principals of each school to our next meeting, noting the topic is "use of facilities. Don to draft letter to be sent to CC times. It was noted the next Brd of Ed meeting was 9/25 @ 1pm at the Brd of Ed building.

Wrestling: They have one more registration, currently 50 registered. Without the use of Century, the number of home meets are limited, Century only allowing Saturday 2-4pm for any Winfield Rec function.

FB/Cheer: Season has begun and the program created a 2<sup>nd</sup> league (I-70) with 2 more football teams, to allow children to play. Next year hope to add a 3<sup>rd</sup> football team and cheerleaders to the I-70 league. A powder puff game and pep rally is scheduled 10/4 with homecoming on 10/5 against North Carroll. Approximately 230 football players and 130 cheerleaders. Tim has cut opening in sea container for press box and installed steps with a door and fencing in rear. Far from done, but work in progress. Plan to get dumpster on 9/26 to clean up debris behind containers
