Meeting called to order by Jean Shea, Vice President

Minutes from the 6/28/04 meeting were accepted and approved by board

Treasurer: Account Balance for Rec Council \$11722.31, Basketball \$15306.16, Lacrosse \$(1889.73) and AAU \$8.39. Fiscal year 2004 income and expense figures submitted to county for all programs except baseball. They never returned figures. Football and soccer owe the \$300 administrative fee plus the \$2.00 per player to WRC

Rec Council Board positions are up for nominations for Vice President and Treasurer. These are two year term positions. Any nominations should be made at the October meeting.

Jackie: Sock hop on 10/1 @ SC Cafeteria 6:30 – 9:30pm, Cost is \$6.00 each. Ages 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade. South Carroll High has requested there be no practice at Mayeski on Thursday 10/14 due to the Homecoming parade starting at 6pm. Entrance to the park will be limited.

Patty Taylor: Mentioned that # of players registered and # of volunteer hours for each program has been turned into the county for the 2004 season. Patti will develop a form to help programs calculate volunteer hours. Patti said league of voters has asked up to set up and take down the voting booths again this year and make \$135. She will get more information out to see who can help.

Wrestling: currently holding registrations and have 100 wrestlers

Softball: Ed Beane and Rick Parker did self help presentation for ball mix for baseball and softball for the 2005 season. Travel is holding pitching clinic on Sundays. Have fall ball teams 1 @ 10&u, 2 @ 12&u, 1 @ 14&u, 2 @ 16&u, 1 @ 18&u. Teams participating in Halloween tournament in Sterling, Va. Looking for gym time on 11/19 and 11/20 for pitching clinic @ Century 6-8pm

Cheerleading: waiting for any open gym times at Century, SC, Linton or Winfield. Mentioned next year hosting competition on Nov 6<sup>th</sup> and would like to reserve South Carroll. Patti said she would check w/ Jim Horn to see if it's a problem.

Football: ½ way thru season. Expanded by adding 10/12 team this year. Still challenge w/ field and lights. Made offer to rent lights to share the back soccer fields w/ soccer. Jean will talk w/ soccer

Soccer: currently 400 players and 27 referees. Ed thanked Kathleen for all that she has done for the rec program and noted she has brought more skills to the program.

Square dance:

Lacrosse: Fred thanked the council and Carol for helping get the lacrosse program started at Winfield. Fred mentioned as with all program, expect the lax program to grow for the 2005 season. Holding registrations on 11/20 (pre-registration) 12/4, 12/11 and 12/18 @ SC . Last year had 20 teams, expect to have at least 22 this year. Lax is concerned w/ field space. Mentioned Freedom program was permitted fields @ Century that they did not use last year. However when SC Lax permitted and used those fields, Freedom fault to get those fields back. No one (including Freedom) used them the remainder of the season. Councils should not have to battle for fields. The county should allocate fields based on # of kids in program. After much discussion, Fred was directed to direct his concerns direct to Bill Schaefer and Jeff Degitz. Fred asked who has priority on fields during each season. It was determined that the sport "in season" would have the priority on field useage.

Basketball: Jean mentioned that John Berger has stepped up to run the Basketball program. Jean will oversee program this year. Basketball registration in on Wed and Sat, information went out to schools.
